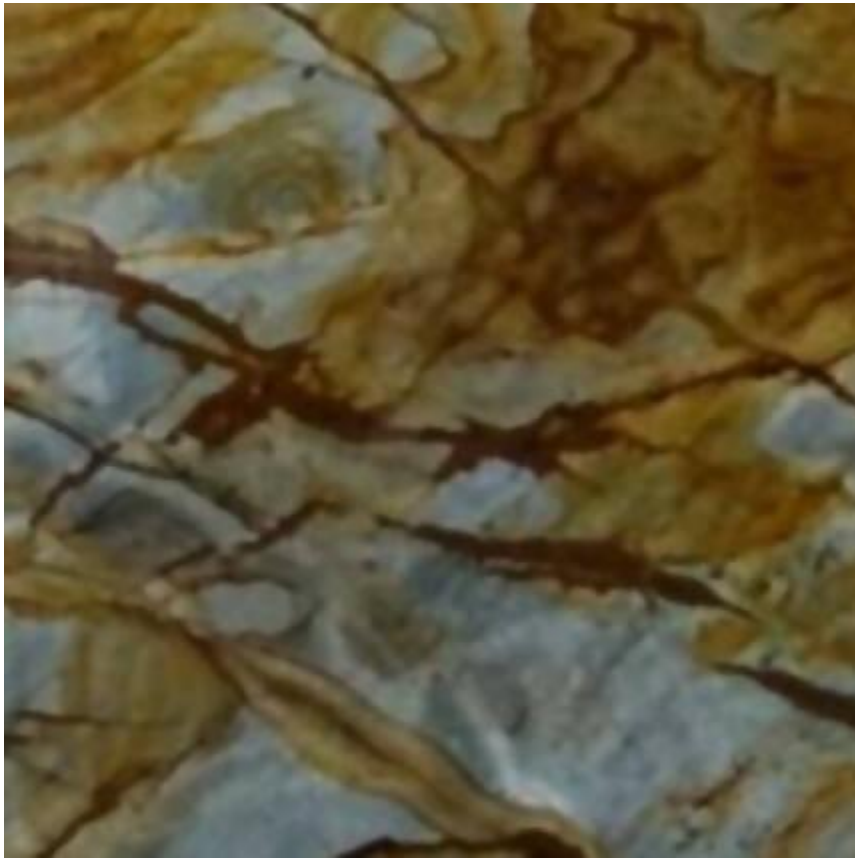

[Blue Mare Exotic Quartzite](#) is a Brazilian stone with a greyish-blue background and rustic veining. Quartzite worktops are porous; they need to be properly sealed to avoid staining and bacterial and fungal contaminations. Sealing is recommended once a year if the quartzite slab is dense and less porous. Though they are scratch-resistant, avoid using abrasive cleaners on the surface, which eventually will wear out the polish.

## Hardness

You don't have to be geology to appreciate quartzite's toughness and durability. This not only provides a hard stone but distinguishes quartzite from imposters. It is more rigid than glass than a knife. These things are simple to test with a stone.

## Acidity Resistance

Acids such as lime juice or vinegar will not etch quartzite. If a quartzite rock becomes scratched from acid, it has been mislabeled. Normal kitchen acids will not etch quartzite at all. Not in the least!

## Porosity

The porosity of quartzite varies. Some have been substantially metamorphosed, and the metals are closely linked together. Blue Mare Exotic Quartzites have been subjected to less extreme pressure, making them more porous and need sealing.

Though quartzite countertops are more expensive than granite, these are well worth the extra cost due to their distinct appearance, stunning patterning, and natural stone textures. ### **Quartzite Countertop Maintenance**



Quartzite is resistant to heat. The stones should be alright if you set a pot or frying sheet on them. Use soap and water or a moist towel to clean a quartzite countertop. There is no need for abrasives. However, because the stone is chemically resistant to harm, you should be alright if you use ordinary cleaning agents. Quartzite is among the most resilient stones and is tougher than quartz, although it is best to safeguard your blades by using a cutting board.



One disadvantage of quartzite is that it must be sealed at least once a year to prevent stains or etching, possibly more frequently. However, it requires less upkeep than marble. Quartzite can be sealed properly.

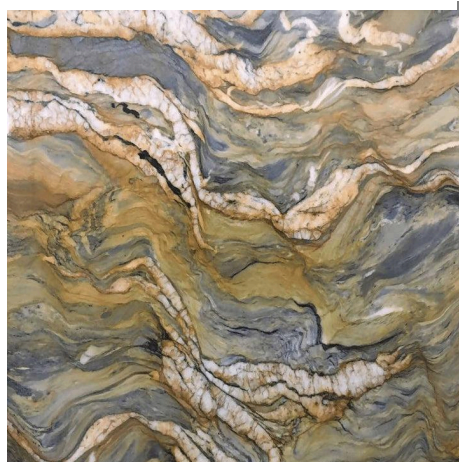

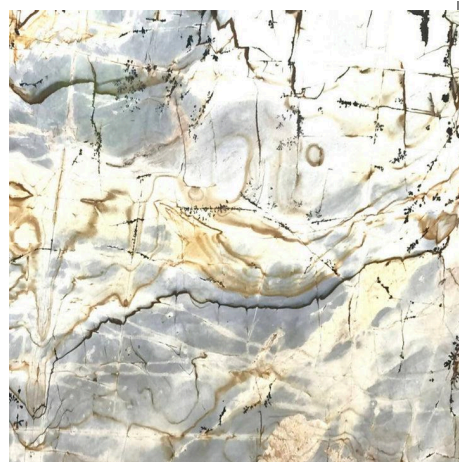
