

Lawrence County, announcing Newcastle as a priority location

What county commissioners will do to persuade them what is needed to build a mini-casino within Lawrence County.

Last year, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf signed a major gambling expansion bill to help fill the \$2 billion gap in the budget. First of all, the gambling expansion plan allowed the 10 largest casinos in the state to open new mini casinos. Emotions were mixed in local governments across the state over whether to welcome new mini casinos or ban gambling houses from the border. Government leaders and residents were tasked with hosting mini casinos and weighing the pros and cons of whether they would decide whether to do as they did. Some municipalities have decided to close their borders for mini casinos, while many others have decided to benefit from opportunities and use gambling houses as an additional source of income. Under regulations developed by the Pennsylvania Game Management Committee, host municipalities will receive 1% of casino total game revenue. This has prompted many municipalities to participate in attracting mini casinos. <u>동행복권파워볼</u>

Where exactly is Airy Mount going to build a mini casino?

The company behind Mount Airy Casino Resort, which conducted a tender process related to the construction of Pennsylvania's third mini-casino, bid for \$21,188,888.88. The company has identified New Castle as the preferred location for casino ventures, but the exact location of the Category 4 mini-casino could be within a 15-mile radius of the city center. In other words, Mini-Casino can be located in northern, eastern, or southeastern Butler County.

Speculation about the exact location of the third mini-casino has begun to rage. Vogler had the opportunity to remind casino developers that they had six months to submit applications and documents. The commissioner explained that Lawrence County "will not play a preferred role for one municipality over another." Vogler explained that it is up to the company to build a mini casino venture.

Commissioner Steve Craig said the county would compete fairly with other counties to host one of the small casinos recently approved by the state legislature. He said competition will be difficult because mini casinos offer a wide range of economic benefits to organizers.
