CHOOSE A STRONG CORE

CONSISTENT ENERGY DISTRIBUTION

Ensure a balanced and consistent energy distribution to increase the likelihood of drawing the necessary energy cards during a match.

UTILIZE TRAINER CARDS EFFECTIVELY:

Include cards that allow you to draw, search your deck, remove your opponent's cards, or recover resources.

SYNERGIZE POKEMON

ABILITIES

Consider combinations that enhance your Pokémon's strengths or cover their weaknesses.

BALANCE BETWEEN POKÉMON AND TRAINERS:

Maintain a balance between Pokémon and Trainer cards to ensure a smooth flow of resources and attackers.
