



Top 10 Most Expensive Premier League Transfers of All Time



The Premier League is known for its financial power, and clubs have consistently spent massive amounts to secure world-class talent. Over the years, the market has seen astronomical deals, with transfer fees climbing higher every season. The [Most Expensive Premier League Transfers](#) list showcases some of the biggest investments clubs have made to strengthen their squads. The 2025 transfer window saw Alexander Isak set a new benchmark, joining Liverpool for £130 million, making him the most expensive player in Premier League history. Alongside him, other high-profile signings like Florian Wirtz (£116.5m), Moises Caicedo (£115m), Enzo Fernandez (£107m), Jack Grealish (£100m), and Paul Pogba (£90m) dominate the records. Clubs like Chelsea, Manchester City, and Manchester United frequently appear in this list, reflecting their financial muscle.

10. Hugo Ekitike | From Eintracht Frankfurt to Liverpool

Hugo Ekitike became Liverpool's record signing in 2025, with a fee reported at £79 million, including £10 million in add-ons. The French striker impressed in Ligue 1 with 22 goals and 12 assists last season. Known for his pace, clinical finishing, and ability to play both as a central striker and wide forward, Ekitike attracted interest from multiple top European clubs. His transfer is now ranked among the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers, and Liverpool see him as a long-term solution to lead their attack alongside Darwin Nunez. The club is investing in him not just for immediate impact but for sustained performance in domestic and European competitions.

9. Antony | From Ajax to Manchester United

Antony joined Manchester United in 2022 for £82 million, making him one of the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. The Brazilian winger is known for his dribbling skills, flair, and ability to create chances from tight spaces. Despite his high potential, Antony struggled to adapt to the Premier League's physicality and fast-paced style. He did contribute to Manchester United's Carabao Cup victory, but inconsistencies in form and injuries have affected his overall performance. His experience highlights that even big-money transfers require time and support to succeed in England's top flight.

8. Paul Pogba | From Juventus to Manchester United

Paul Pogba's return to Manchester United in 2016 for £90 million made him one of the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers of that period. Pogba is celebrated for his vision, passing range, and ability to score from midfield. However, his time at Manchester United was marked by inconsistency and off-field controversies. Despite this, Pogba played a key role in United's Europa League triumph and brought his world-class experience to the Premier League. Additionally, winning the 2018 World Cup with France added to his profile as one of the most sought-after midfielders of his generation.

7. Romelu Lukaku | From Inter Milan to Chelsea

Romelu Lukaku's £97.5 million move to Chelsea in 2021 positioned him among the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. The Belgian striker was known for his strength, goal-

scoring instincts, and ability to hold up play for his teammates. However, his Chelsea stint was less successful due to tactical mismatches, high expectations, and managerial conflicts. Despite this, Lukaku's previous performances at Inter Milan and subsequent success at Napoli, where he won the Serie A title, underline his quality as a top-class forward.

6. Jack Grealish | From Aston Villa to Manchester City

Jack Grealish joined Manchester City in 2021 for £100 million, making him one of the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. Known for his dribbling, vision, and ability to draw fouls in dangerous areas, Grealish was a standout performer at Aston Villa. At Manchester City, he contributed to Premier League and Champions League victories but struggled at times to adapt to Pep Guardiola's tactical system. His technical skills, versatility on the wings, and creativity remain valuable assets, showing why City invested heavily in acquiring him.

5. Declan Rice | From West Ham United to Arsenal

Declan Rice joined Arsenal in 2023 for £105 million, becoming Britain's most expensive player at the time and one of the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. Rice is celebrated for his defensive intelligence, tackling ability, and distribution skills. He operates as a box-to-box midfielder while also excelling as a holding midfielder, allowing Arsenal to maintain balance in attack and defense. His leadership qualities on the field and consistent performances have already made him a central figure in Arsenal's pursuit of domestic and European success.

4. Enzo Fernandez | From Benfica to Chelsea

Enzo Fernandez moved to Chelsea in 2023 for £107 million, ranking him among the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. The Argentine midfielder is known for his excellent passing, ball control, and ability to dictate the tempo of games. Initially, Fernandez faced challenges adapting to the Premier League's intensity and frequent managerial changes at Chelsea. Over time, he became a key contributor, helping Chelsea win the 2025 FIFA Club World Cup. His signing demonstrates Chelsea's ambition to secure young talent capable of influencing matches at the highest level.

3. Moises Caicedo | From Brighton to Chelsea

Moises Caicedo's £115 million move to Chelsea in 2023 makes him one of the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. Caicedo excels in both defensive and attacking roles as a box-to-box midfielder. Known for his stamina, tackling, and composure on the ball, he quickly became a pivotal figure in Chelsea's midfield. After a period of adjustment, Caicedo's performances contributed to Chelsea's international successes, including lifting the [FIFA Club World Cup](#), proving his value as a high-investment player.

2. Florian Wirtz | From Bayer Leverkusen to Liverpool

Florian Wirtz joined [Liverpool](#) in 2025 for £116.5 million, making him the club's record signing before Alexander Isak. Wirtz is regarded as a highly skilled playmaker, capable of creating chances, scoring, and controlling the pace of the game. His signing is among the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers and reflects Liverpool's commitment to investing in young, talented players. After the tragic loss of Diogo Jota, Wirtz has stepped up as a central figure in Liverpool's attacking setup, showcasing his technical brilliance and potential for long-term impact.

1. Alexander Isak | From Newcastle United to Liverpool

Alexander Isak became the most expensive player in Premier League history after joining Liverpool for £130 million in 2025. The Swedish striker scored 27 goals in the 2024–25 season, leading Newcastle to their first Carabao Cup win in 56 years. Isak's transfer, including a £5 million solidarity fee, is now the top entry among the Most Expensive Premier League Transfers. Known for his strength, agility, and goal-scoring instincts, Isak is expected to transform Liverpool's attack and bring long-term success to the club.
