Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) systems offer real-time tracking and trends, often paired with insulin pumps. HbA1c home tests measure average blood sugar levels over time by analyzing sugar-bound hemoglobin. While less precise than lab tests, these home tests can be convenient for those with limited access to medical facilities, enabling data sharing with healthcare providers.
