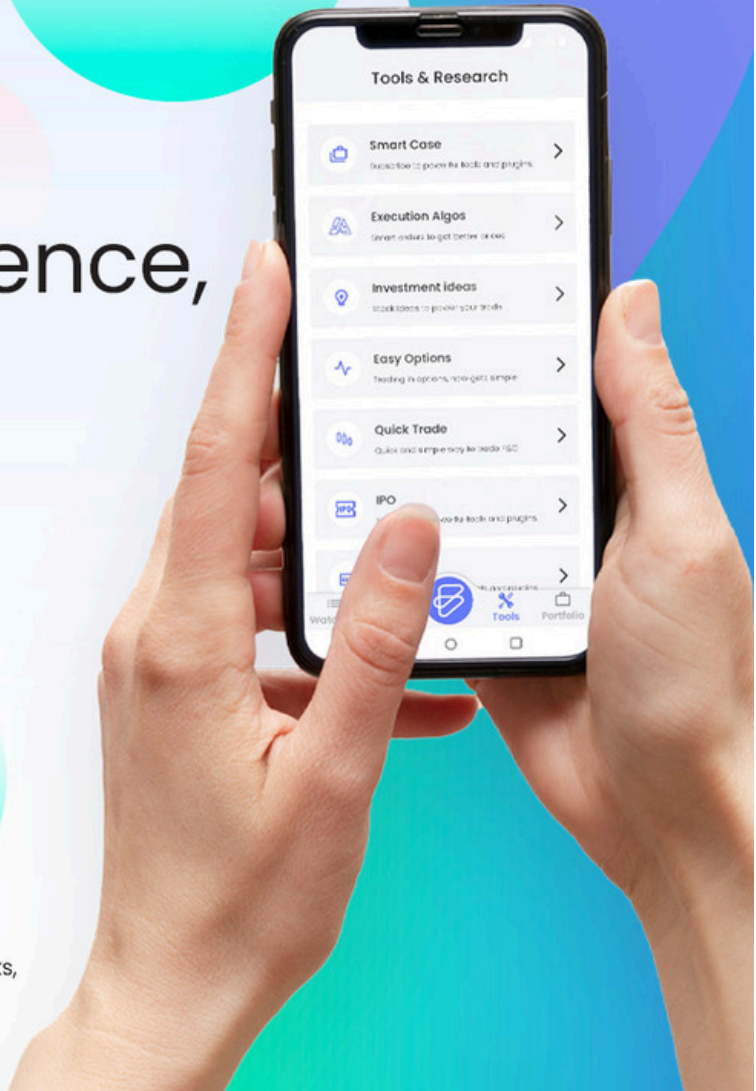
- 1- Via Depository Participant's Portal
