



Hurley Re-signs 6 years and 69.2 billion won with Connecticut University after refusing Lakers coach

Coach Dan Hurley, who led the University of Connecticut to a second consecutive year in men's basketball at the NCAA, has renewed his contract for six years.

AP, ESPN and other foreign media reported on the 9th ([실시간 바카라사이트](#)) that Hurley, who recently rejected the NBA's LA Lakers coach offer, signed a six-year, \$50 million contract with the University of Connecticut.

As a result, Hurley will lead Connecticut University from 2029 to 2030.

In addition to the basic salary, you can earn additional incentives based on your performance every year. Next season, you will receive a basic salary of 400,000 dollars, plus 6.375 million dollars including lectures and bonuses for consulting.

Hurley led Connecticut from the 2018-2019 season to the 2023-2024 season, recording 141 wins and 58 losses. He topped the list for two consecutive seasons in the 2022-2023 season and the 2023-2024 season.

The Lakers reportedly offered Hurley a six-year, 70-million-dollar offer last month. Hurley, however, has decided to stay in college.

"The Lakers' proposal was very tempting," Hurley said. "It is an honor to coach basketball at the University of Connecticut, to represent a world-class institution and a great state of Connecticut. We will continue to foster good and young players and pursue historical success."
