



Embracing God's Love and Transcendence: Discovering the Divine's Unconditional Love and Nature of Go

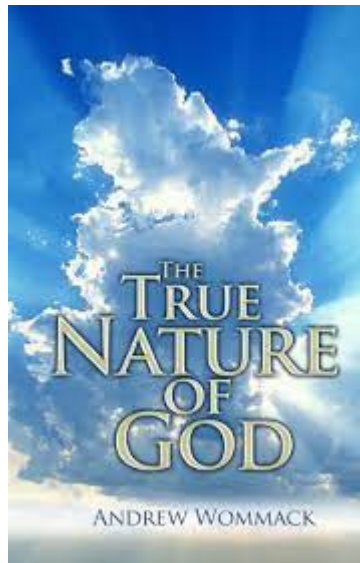
