

How to Write Perfect CV For Engineers Australia in 2022/2023



Engineers in Australia are required to <u>submit a CV/resume</u> when applying for skill assessment, membership with Engineers Australia, becoming a <u>chartered engineer</u>, or registering in the <u>National Engineer Register</u>. The CV is crucial to the application process as it highlights an engineer's technical knowledge and industrial abilities.

When preparing a CV for a Competency Demonstration Report (CDR), it is important to include every minor detail about the work done and the workplace. This includes mentioning completed projects in academic and professional careers, as well as periods of inactivity. - Showcase progression in the engineering career in the last 10 years to demonstrate expertise and continuous learning.
- Include all completed projects in detail to allow the assessor to check abilities accordingly. If inactive for a period, include a valid reason.

To ensure the CV meets Engineers Australia's requirements, here are some rules to follow:

- Use between three and five A4 pages.
- Use a font size between 11 to 12.
- Details on employment held more than two years ago are not necessary.
- Check grammatical errors before submitting.
- Claims made on the application should be checked during interviews.
- Exclude details regarding prior wages, bonus payments, etc.
- Write the CV in simple English without using jargon or initials.
- Include hobbies and interests outside of the workplace.
- Present the CV in PDF format.

When writing a perfect engineer's CV in Australia, here are some important points to focus on:

- Include a short and precise career objective.
- Write education qualifications in ascending order.
- Clearly mention work experience.
- Write projects with working periods and clearly state the role and objective.
- Mention software skills related to the field.
- Include personal details with contact number and email address.
- Submit references when asked by the assessor.
- Keep the CV between 3 to 4 pages.
