- Loud Noises (Acoustic Trauma) Explosions, gunshots, or loud concerts can generate sound waves strong enough to perforate the eardrum.
- Eustachian Tube Dysfunction (ETD) Poor ear pressure regulation can weaken the eardrum, making it more susceptible to rupture.

Symptoms of a Perforated Eardrum

A perforation can lead to various symptoms, including:

- Sudden ear pain that may diminish quickly
- · Partial hearing loss or muffled sounds
- · Fluid or pus drainage from the ear
- Tinnitus (ringing or buzzing sounds in the ear)
- Dizziness or balance issues

When to Consider Surgery

Most minor perforations heal within a few weeks. However, surgery may be necessary if:

- The perforation remains open for more than three months
- Significant hearing loss occurs
- Recurrent ear infections develop
- Persistent ear drainage does not improve with medication

A surgical procedure called myringoplasty can repair a perforated eardrum by using a small tissue graft. This helps restore hearing, reduce infection risks, and protect the middle ear from further complications.
