



Women's Volleyball Lee Da-hyun Southeast Asian Star

Middle blocker Lee Da-hyun (23, Suwon Hyundai Engineering & Construction Hillstate) is establishing himself as a sports star that encompasses Indonesia, the world's fourth-largest population, beyond South Korea.

The Indonesian daily "Pikiran Rakyat" focused on "Lee Da-hyun, who is active in the 2023-24 Korean Women's Professional Volleyball Hyundai Engineering & Construction," is one of the top 10 sports contents on March 11.

"Pikiran Rakyat" is a 57-year-old newspaper published mainly in Bandung, West Java. According to mid-2023 estimates, Bandung is Indonesia's second largest urban area with 8,872,957 people.

The V-League women's team has emerged as an object of interest in Indonesia as Megawati anti-estry Pertiwi (25) joined Red Sparks, Daejeon's presidential office, this season. "Lee Da-hyun is receiving the attention of volleyball fans," said "Pikiran Rakyat," introducing the local atmosphere.

Indonesia is also the world's seventh largest economic market based on purchasing power parity. "He has not only outstanding performance but also good looks," said Pikiran Rakyat, explaining why Lee Da-hyun is the talk of the town.

Lee has become a rising star in the 2021 Korea Volleyball Federation (KOVO) Cup, and ranked seventh in the women's category of the 2021-22 V-League. She ranks sixth in blocking per set in the 2023-24 regular season.

"Pikiran Rakyat" showed that Lee Da-hyun's popularity in Indonesia is unusual by reporting on family relations such as Ryu Yeon-soo, a mother who was sixth in the 7th Presidential Volleyball Competition and Lee Joon-young, a younger brother of Korean university volleyball players.

Ryu Yeon-soo participated in the 11th Beijing Asian Games in 1990 and Lee Da-hyun participated in the 19th Hangzhou Asian Games in 2023. "Pikiran Rakyat" also did not miss
