

Son Heung-min Becomes Tottenham's 'Salary King'...Earning \$312.64 Million a Week

Son Heung-min is the highest paid player at Tottenham Hotspur, according to a new report.

British media outlet 'TeamTalk' revealed the salary ranking of Tottenham's squad as of the 2023/2024 season based on data from sports economics website 'Capology' on Nov. 19 (KST).

According to the report, Tottenham's total wage bill for the season is £1,284 million (approximately KRW 1,856 billion). In terms of weekly wages, that's £2.17 million.

Last season, the top spot was held by Harry Kane, who earned £200,000 per week, but Kane left for Bayern Munich this summer, leaving runner-up Son Heung-min to take the top spot.

It's not out of the question that his weekly salary could rise further. Reports from multiple outlets last month suggested that Tottenham were preparing to reward Son for his consistent performances with the gift of a long-term contract.

The next highest weekly wage earner after Son is, surprisingly, Perisic. Perisic earns a weekly wage of £180,000 (approximately \$296.19 million). However, he suffered an anterior cruciate ligament injury last month and is out for the season.

Maddison, who joined Tottenham this summer, rounds out the top three. He earns a weekly wage of £170,000 (approximately \$279,973). With two goals and five assists this season, he's certainly done his part.
