

Paris Olympics 'Stolen Warning'

It has been reported that an athlete who participated in the 2024 Paris Olympics suffered damage from the theft of 75 million won worth of precious metals.

According to France's Anpo on the 25th (local time), Argentina's national soccer team coach Javier Mascherano said in an interview with his own media the day before that one of his team members was damaged.

"Yesterday, a thief broke into the training ground and stole things," Mascherano said. "Thiago Almadar lost his watch and ring." The coach explained that Almadar did not want to disclose this before the game began, so he only revealed it after the game.<u>메이저사이트</u>

"They (organizers) ask us for certification or identification in every case, and this happens," he said. On the same day, the audience stormed during the match against Morocco and even threw a water bottle, and it seems that they were dissatisfied with the security of the French side.

Citing police officials, the media reported that a theft occurred in the stadium locker room on the 23rd. At that time, the Argentine national team was found to have trained the team at August Dury Stadium in Saint-Etienne ahead of the game.

Almadah reportedly reported a watch worth 40,000 euros and a ring worth 10,000 euros. The damage was approximately 75 million won (approx.

Meanwhile, Argentina lost to Morocco 1-2. Almada is an attacking midfielder who has played for Atlanta United of the U.S. Major League Soccer since 2022 before moving to Botafogo in Brazil this year.
