



## Star Barcelona Midfielder Assures He is ‘feeling good’ After MOTM Performance Against Espanyol



Dani Olmo made a significant impact during Barcelona's 3-1 win over Espanyol. The attacking midfielder, who marked his return to the starting XI for the first time after suffering an injury in the game against Girona, proved that he had fully recovered, scoring two goals in the first half and marking a strong return to the starting eleven.

“I feel good, I wanted to come back, help the team, keep enjoying myself, playing and winning,” he said.

Having netted five goals so far this season, he expressed happiness with his performance, noting that he had confidence in achieving these numbers when he joined the club due to his familiarity with the environment and his teammates.

“It’s not bad (scoring five goals), I’m happy with how it turned out. I was confident I could have these numbers when I came here because I knew the club and the players.”

Barcelona’s attacking prowess has been impressive, reaching a remarkable total of 40 goals in La Liga. Olmo highlighted the strength of the team’s offensive capabilities, stating that they are a squad capable of scoring many goals.

“We are a team that has a lot of goals, both the scorers and the second line, we play directly and we create many chances.”
