


EFOGEFOG-EBCOG Part 1 Exam 2024: Comprehensive Overview

EFOG EBCOG Part 1 Exam Structure 2024

The computer-based Knowledge Assessment test known as EFOG EBCOG Part 1 is an essential tool for assessing candidates' obstetrics and gynecology knowledge. To sit for the <u>EFOG EBCOG Part 2</u> exam, candidates must pass the EBCOG-EFOG Part 1 exam.

Eligibility Criteria for EFOG-EBCOG Exam 2024

In order to sit for the <u>EFOG-EBCOG Exam in 2024</u>, candidates must fulfill certain qualifying requirements. These prerequisites include being licensed medical practitioners and possessing a main medical degree. Additionally, the candidates need to be listed on their respective nations' Medical Practitioners' Registers.

Candidates must have completed a minimum of three years of training in order to sit for the EFOG EBCOG Part 1 exam. Those who qualify for the Part 2 exam have to take it no later than three years after finishing Part 1. There will be a retake of the Part 1 exam if Part 2 is not attempted within this time frame or if the test is not passed within 3 years.
