- **Definition:** Sex work involves adults providing consensual sexual services in exchange for income or goods.

- **Penalties:** Illegal to advertise in public telephone boxes and to publish obscene content.
- **Internet Restrictions:** Advertising on platforms hosted in countries where sex work or its advertising is banned can lead to penalties.

Do Sex Workers Need to Pay Taxes?

- **Tax Obligations:** According to HM Revenue & Customs, sex workers must declare earnings and are liable to Income Tax.

- **Hiring Escorts:** Legal to hire an escort in the UK.
- **Sex Trafficking:** Illegal to pay a sex worker forced into sexual activity without consent; strict liability offense.
- **Age Restrictions:** Illegal to pay for sex from a person under 18, despite the age of consent being 16.
- **Soliciting in Public:** Illegal and can lead to legal trouble.
