



Harra's Joliet casino workers rescue man injured in shooting

The incident happened around 5 a.m. when the victim was standing near the eastern entrance to the Ottawa Street parking deck, which is close to the Will County Courthouse, Shaw Local reported. Joliet Police Department Sergeant Dwayne English said the man was shot in both legs as the fight with the suspect intensified. The shooter came from a nearby alley and fired several shots before running away.

Despite the injuries, the victim walked on a parking deck and reached Harrah's Casino on 151 N. Joliet Street. Casino workers took quick action when they saw the injured man. They told the local authorities what had happened and gave first aid until emergency medical services appeared. Joliet Fire Department officials then took the man to Ascent Saint Joseph Medical Center. His injuries are not life-threatening, and doctors think he will get better.

The English sergeant praised casino employees for their quick action, pointing out that their speed helped the victim get medical care. According to the English sergeant, the shooting was a target. He also mentioned that the investigation was in its early stages and that the police were actively looking for a suspect.

Harrah's Joliet Casino is not the site of the shooting, but it has become a key place to save the victims. The closure of the casino and the vigilance of the staff played a major role after the violent incident. The shooting near the Ottawa Street parking lot involved a recent shooting in Joliet. Earlier that day, another incident occurred at the Fairfield Inn on Riverboat Center Drive. Hotel staff called 911 when they heard multiple shots.

Police did not find any victims, but they found traces of the shooting in a parking lot. In the past seven days, Joliet experienced six shootings that caused concern among local people. The city's police are asking anyone who knows something or has a video of these incidents to speak out.
