

Meta Warns Its Latest Large Language Model 'May Not Be Suitable' for Non-English Use

Meta is back with a new large language model (LLM) — Llama 2, which was released via a <u>research paper published</u> in July 2023. Llama 2 is the successor to Llama 1, which Meta <u>introduced in February 2023</u>.

In a move that Yann LeCun, VP and Chief Al Scientist at Meta, described as "huge" in a July 18 tweet, the tech giant has chosen to make Llama 2 both open source and available for free for research and commercial use. Users will therefore be able to start building on Llama 2.
