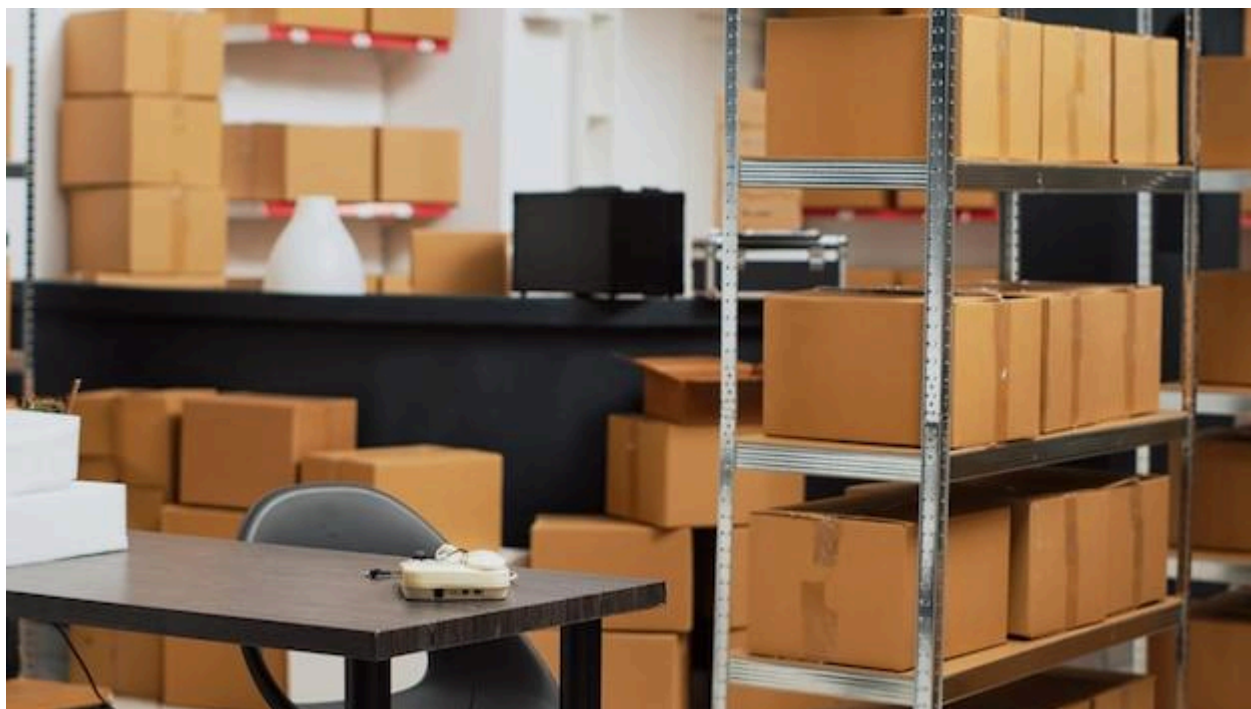




Top 3 Benefits of Renting a Warehouse with Office Space in Houston
