

Can Kane be cleared of the 'Lord of Irrelevance' stigma in Euro 2024

"Let's decide the strongest soccer player in Europe". Germany opens early on the 15th With Kane's still scoring ability, his teammates also said, "Luxury Corps." England's favorite to win... Germany and France also pay attention!

"King of Irrelevance" Harry Kane Bayern Munich will try to win the title again at the 2024 European Championship Euro 2024. Considering Kane's recent momentum and the potential of English players on the list for this year's tournament, some predict that this is a golden opportunity for Kane to lift the trophy.

Euro 2024 will kick off at 4 a.m. on the 15th with the host Germany and Scotland match at Allianz Arena in Munich, Germany.

Euro 2024 is a football competition between European countries that is held every four years by the UEFA. It is sometimes called the "Mini World Cup" as big soccer clubs are concentrated in Europe. This year, just like in 2020, 24 countries will participate in the competition, and the competition will take place in 10 stadiums in Germany.

Kane, will you be able to clean up your sorrows

Euro 2024 gives Kane an opportunity to get rid of his sorrows. Kane has proved himself as the "best scorer" by scoring 36 goals and eight assists in the league since the first season after moving to the Bundesliga. He also scored eight goals and four assists in the Champions League. Kane has displayed his individual skills to the fullest regardless of team's ranking. He was awarded the Player of the Month award five times as a result of his performance.

That is not all. England, which also includes Kane, has formed a "magnitude of luxury" to win this year's championship. Examples include Jude Bellingham, who led Spain's Real Madrid to win the Champions League, and Phil Foden, who led Manchester City to win the EPL's "Player of the Year" for four consecutive seasons. Ollie Watkins, Bukayo Saka, who scored 19 and 16 goals, respectively, and Declan Rice, who scored seven goals and eight assists, all of them in the EPL last season. For this reason, England is considered a likely candidate for Euro 2024.

In fact, Opta, a sports statistics media outlet, rated England's probability of winning the championship the highest at 19.9 percent. The second place is France, which has Kylian Mbappe Real Madrid. France had a 19.1 percent chance of winning the championship, just 0.8 percentage point ahead of England. Even on Bet365, a U.K. betting site, an absolute majority of betting participants predicted England would win.

Host Germany, Mbappe's Country France also won the title

Germany, the host country, is also considered a favorite to win the title at this year's event. Germany, which was eliminated from both World Cups, including Russia in 2018 and Qatar in 2022, lost in the round of 16 match against its home team England at Euro 2020, and had to pack early on. As it took longer to struggle, its FIFA ranking fell to 16th.

Noteworthy is France's Kylian Mbappe and Portugal's Cristiano Ronaldo Al-Narce. France is the strongest candidate following England, and will likely display strong performance by maintaining full capacity during the Qatar World Cup, including Mbappe and Antoine Griezmann Atletico Madrid. Ronaldo is the only player to advance to the Euro tournament for the sixth time, and will set a new record by participating in the tournament itself.
