

Re-entering the Big League on behalf of Luzar, who also had a back injury

Sean Anderson, who pushed Ko Woo-suk out of the 40-man roster, is called up again.

MLBTR reported on Sunday (Korea Standard Time) that the Miami Marlins will call up Anderson as they put left-handed pitcher Jesus Luzardo on the injured list on Wednesday due to back injury. It came a week after he was demoted to Triple-A. 스포츠토토사이트

Miami acquired Anderson from the Texas Rangers in a cash trade on May 31. It also acquired Ko from the Rangers to make room for Anderson.

Since then, Ko Woo-seok's status has been transferred to the minor leagues.

Anderson was called up to the big leagues on the 15th after taking the mound twice in Triple-A.

However, Anderson started against the Washington Nationals and was sluggish with 10 hits and seven runs in two innings.

Miami then sent Anderson down to Triple-A on the 16th and called up Kent Emanuel. The 30-year-old right-hander Anderson pitched in 14 games for the KIA Tigers of the KBO League last season, going 79 innings, 4-7 with a 3.76 ERA.

Making his big league debut with the San Francisco Giants in 2019, he went through San Francisco, the Minnesota Twins, the Baltimore Orioles, the San Diego Padres, the Toronto Blue Jays, and the Texas Rangers, playing a total of 65 games and 139 innings in five big league seasons, recording a 3-5 record with a 5.83 ERA.
