Eligibility Criteria

<u>eligibility To sit for the MRCP</u> Part 1 exam, candidates must hold a medical degree from a university recognized by the GMC (General Medical Council) and have at least one year of post-graduate experience. This exam offers an excellent opportunity for medical professionals looking to advance their careers internationally.

Important MRCP Exam Dates

Registration for the MRCP Part 1 exam opened on July 3 and closed on June 10 for the third exam of 2024. The exam will take place on August 14, 2024, with results announced on September 13.

Exam Format and Next Steps

The MRCP Part 1 exam comprises two sessions, each featuring 100 multiple-choice questions in a best-of-five format. The total exam duration is six hours, divided equally between the two sessions on the same day.
