



LVCVA Sets Date for Convention Center Groundbreaking Ceremony

The Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority will hold a ceremonial groundbreaking ceremony to celebrate the beginning of the second phase of expansion of the Las Vegas Convention Center District (LVCCD). The project will secure Las Vegas as the world's top business destination for decades to come.

The LVCCD Phase II, \$860 million expansion project will add 1.4 million square feet to the current facility, including at least 600,000 square feet of new, rentable exhibition space. The expansion will be completed in time for CES 2021. [바카라사이트 추천](#)

In 2016, Las Vegas hosted nearly 22,000 conferences, conventions, and trade shows, directly supporting the estimated \$2.3 billion in wages and salaries for approximately 54,800 jobs. The Las Vegas Convention Center directly supported 22% of convention attendees travel to Southern Nevada, with approximately 11,800 jobs paying \$495 million in wages and salaries. Attendees at the Las Vegas Convention Center generated \$2.7 billion in economic effects across the local economy, including indirect and triggering impacts.
