They will pop up over and over throughout all the higher numbers, so it is very important to memorize one through ten correctly. I should mention here that it's really important to memorize , but we'll stick with to start with. For the other German numbers between 13 and 19 you take the first four letters of the number between three and nine (like the rule above) and add the word zehn or ten at the end: dreizehn (“thirteen”), vierzehn (“fourteen”), fünfzehn. • German ‘V’ and ‘F’ are more or less the same sound. ‘V’ will always sound like ‘F’, so get used to that — on the contrary, the letter ‘W’ in German is pronounced like an English ‘V’: the word for water is Wasser, pronounced ‘vahsser’. So the German number two is ‘zwei’ pronounced like ‘ts-v-eye’.
