The more such organizations exist, the more difficult they are to achieve. An organization should have strong leadership and a solid follow-up relationship. Considering the appointment of coach Jurgen Klinsmann, Klinsmann's working attitude, the sluggishness of the Korean men's national soccer team at the Asian Cup, and conflicts between players, it can be seen how sloppy the Korea Football Association and the national team were.

It is a well-known fact that Klinsmann was wrong from the appointment. The national team's discipline, discipline, and sense of community weakened. Klinsmann stayed in one place for a while, and immediately left when he had to eat or do something. As he described himself, he was a person who wanted to fly with a bird.

The internal organization of the national team was not very tight, either. The coaches who assisted Klinsmann were not very close. Since they each lived in their own country and worked remotely, they didn't have a chance to get close to each other. Rumor has it that they

couldn't even give Clinsmann the right advice. It is hard to expect sincerity and sincerity in a face-to-face relationship. The players' distrust of the national team's mandatory team remained. The 2701st incident in the Qatar World Cup is a case in point. There was Korea's best orthopedic surgeon in the mandatory team, but the players trusted their personal trainers more. Son Heung-min and Lee Kang-in were also sealed to some extent. The association formed an unconventional power reinforcement committee and put a huge burden on Hwang Sun-hong amid an incomprehensible decision-making structure. The first thing the association and the national team should do is to restore trust, not win.
