



How Long Does the Key Cutting Process Take?

They often contemplate how long it takes to get one's key to be cut. The time that it is going to take depends on the factors such as the kind of key that is being cut, the equipment being used, and the person cutting the key. The following are the factors that impact key cutting time:

Nature and Kind of the Key:

The sort of key that requires duplication determines the time it will take. Blank residential keys or office keys can easily be duplicated within a short time, which could take even less than fifteen minutes. And while making the simplest keys or STEM keys, it may take less time, whereas for more complicated keys or specialty keys, the time to make them may be a lot longer because of their design.

Standard keys:

These are ordinary-looking keys; it is just that they are not used on any door we know. Slicing these usually takes 1 to 5 minutes.

High-security keys:

They have special cuttings to perform specific patterns, and this takes a longer time compared to the flat-surfaced ones. It should take roughly between 10 and 20 minutes.

Car keys with transponders: Of these, some need not only a cutting of the chip but also programming of the chip as well.

2. Key cutting method

Manual key cutting:

Old or manual typewriters might take more time to replicate the key, and this could take comparatively longer time as compared to their modern counterparts. Manual machines entail the work of the locksmith, whereby he has to use his/her own judgment, which may take approximately 5-10 minutes.

Automatic machines:

Machines are modern, and they are capable of making the process of cutting a key very fast depending on the type of key that is being made; that is, it only takes up to a minute to make one key. These are frequent in the hardware stores or self-service kiosks, for example, where time is an important aspect.

3. Shape and state of the first key

Also, the shape and the state of the original key are crucial as well. Copy keying may also take time if it is illuminated from a worn-out or damaged key being copied since the locksmith has to engrave various rooms to make a copy that will open or fit the original correctly.

4. Time of year

As mentioned above, key cutting may take more time depending on the time of the year due to a variety of factors. For example, if you are copying a slender key with an irregular profile or of some certain material, the locksmith has to utilize specific equipment, which has to be prepared for usage, and this will take time.

Key cutting services available for people in different places

The majority of the hardware stores have key cutting services. Due to the fact that most of these stores use automatic machines, it does not take even a few minutes, and you may be given the key. For simple house keys, that shouldn't take you more than five minutes to have one custom made if none of the pre-made keys fit your lock.

2. Locksmith Shops

In case you are in need of a new high-security key or a car key, it would be most appropriate that you run to a professional locksmith. Some locksmiths use enhanced equipment and are capable with difficult types of keys.

Nevertheless, the process of cutting and programming these keys may vary from twenty minutes to one hour.

3. Self-service kiosks

Some establishments have automatic machines whereby you can insert a key and it self-sharpen. These are touch kiosks and are very easy and fast; it only takes 1 to 2 minutes for the standard key.

In most cases, getting a key cut should not take a long period of time.
