

Gateway Casino and Entertainment's planned \$70 million CA facility

Delta City Council is scheduled for three regular meetings in April, one of which is expected to discuss applications for casino zoning changes. In September, Canadian gambling company Gateway Casino & Entertainment announced it had received approval from the British Columbia Lottery Company (BCLC) to relocate the Newton Community Game Center in Surrey to its current Delta Town and Country Inn site. If this hotel is demolished by Green City, it will be provided for this casino project.

Gateway has filed a zoning application for the property at 6005 Highway 17A with the aim of changing the status of the land from the C3 commercial tourism zone to the comprehensive development zone. Once approved, the area will be able to build an entertainment complex with hotels, casinos, multiple restaurants and conference facilities. The company has already held several public information conferences in connection with this application, and in February, it can introduce a dedicated Gateway website for residents' feedback. <u>카지노사이트</u>

The company says the community is very active in the process, but there is no comment on the online forum set up by Gateway, and city officials have supported the casino despite no final decision, and private developers say a \$70 million casino investment is expected to create about 700 jobs and boost the local economy.

Once the zoning application is approved, the project will proceed with the application for additional permission from the city and the city. Construction work will then begin by the end of the year and a grand opening is planned in 2020. Gateway Casino and Entertainment Ltd said the proposed casino would bring about a \$70 million investment in the Delta economy and up to 700 new paid jobs in the region. In addition, this planned complex will result in 500 years of employment.

The proposed Gateway Casino Delta will be built at its current location in Delta Town & Country Inn and will be located on approximately 11 acres. It will include approximately 70,000 square feet of entertainment space and a gaming floor that can accommodate up to 600 slot machines (approximately 500 square meters), 24 game tables and multiple electronic tables. The comprehensive entertainment complex also includes a five-story hotel with 116 rooms and

a variety of food and conference spaces and conference rooms, including Gateway's flagship casino and restaurant brands.

According to data from Gateway's Delta Project Brocher, the new casino will increase employment and significantly increase the number of tourists in the hospitality industry in the region. Delta City's economic benefits include an annual revenue share of \$1.5 million to \$3 million and an estimated annual salary of \$25 million.
