



Manchester United's 'sick finger' Rashford raises possibility of transferring to 'Rival' Arsenal

Will Manchester United goaltender Marcus Rashford move to rival club Arsenal?
"Argente is interested in signing Rashford with uncertain surroundings."

Rashford, who joined Manchester United's youth team in 2005, signed a professional contract with the first team in January 2016. He made a strong impression in the 2015/16 season when he made his professional debut with eight goals and two assists in 18 official matches. At that time, Rashford was only 18 years old.

Since then, Rashford has established himself as Manchester United's main wing forward. From the 2018/19 season to the 2020/21 season, Rashford has achieved double-digit goals in the English Premier League. There have been ups and downs, but last season, he became Manchester United's main gunman with 30 goals and 10 assists in 56 official matches.

Rashford, who thought his skills were in full bloom, fell back into the decline this season. In the 2023/24 season, Rashford has been silent with eight goals and five assists in 40 games. Manchester United's offense has weakened significantly as Rashford fell into a slump. Manchester City, Liverpool, Tottenham Hotspur and Chelsea scored 52 points in the league, but Manchester United scored fewer points than Arsenal, Manchester City, Liverpool, Tottenham Hotspur and Chelsea. When Rashford failed to survive at Manchester United, rumors of a transfer were suddenly raised. David Onstein, a reporter with the highest public confidence in the global sports media The Athletic, said on the 1st, "Manchester United will consider selling Rashford if he arrives with a significant offer and says he wants to leave." According to "Team Talk," Manchester United set Rashford's ransom at least 70 million pounds (about 120.1 billion won).

The club that Rashford plays for is Arsenal. Manchester United and Arsenal were rivals of Alex Ferguson and Arsen Wenger who competed for the league title. If the deal is successful, it could come as a small shock to Manchester United.
