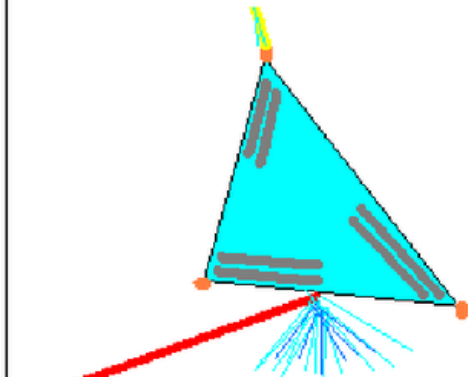

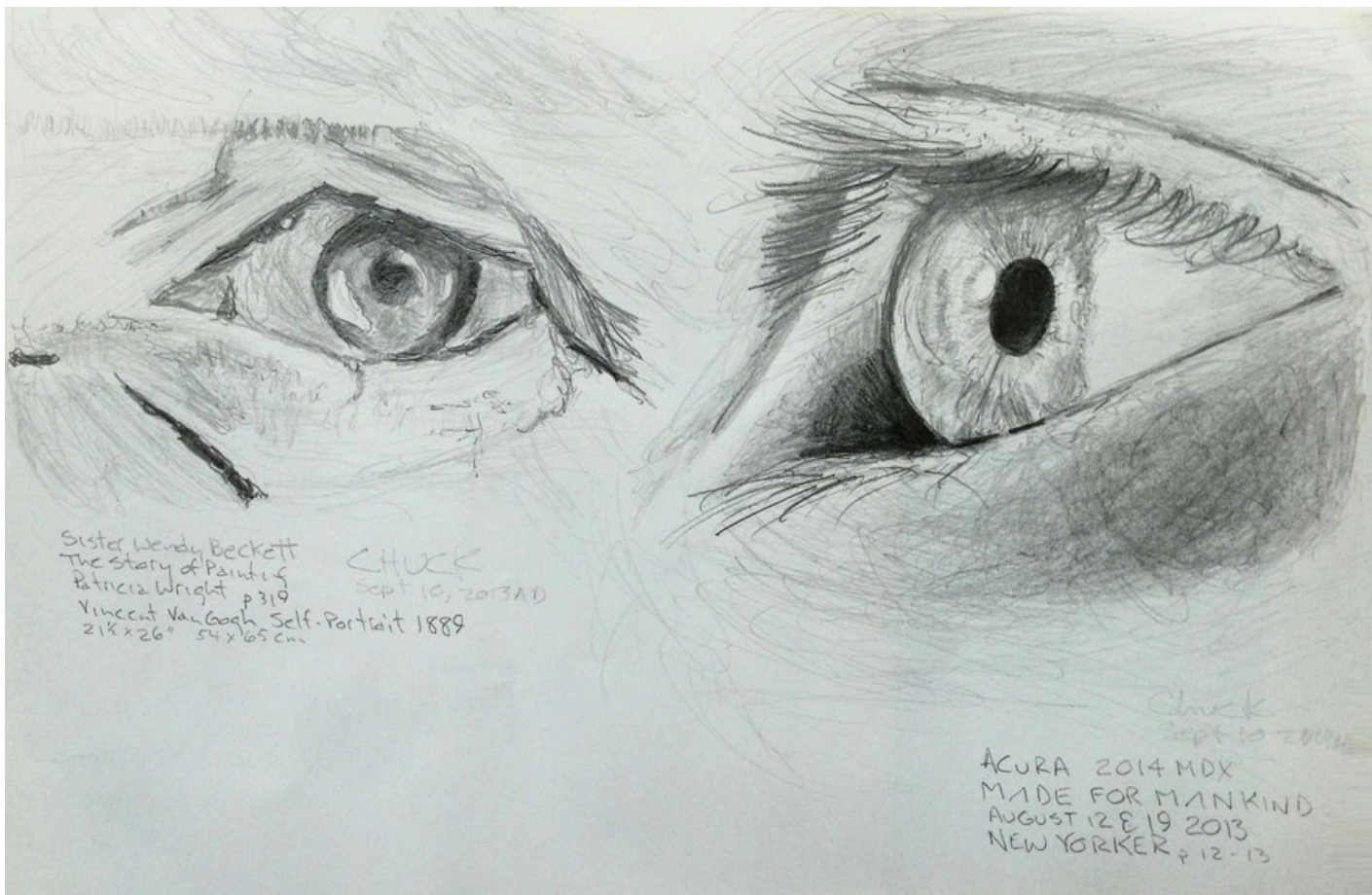
If the bag is damaged by a severe collision, it would re-enter as water.
