The appearance of opal that makes it easily recognizable is the play of colors or opalescence. What distinguishes opal from other stones is that it does not simply glow with a single hue but paints the full rainbow, which can change with the movement or when the light is thrown at it. This is called an optical effect, which is a result of the microscopic silica spheres within the stone reflecting light and creating these rainbows.

The change in colors can go from bold, bright, and overwhelming ones such as Red, Orange, blue, or green rather to faint shades of violet or yellow, respectively. It is interesting to note that every opal has different colors, and there are no two opals that are similar in color patterns. The intensity, pattern, and range of colors play an important role in making opal valuable and beautiful.
