

Bayern Munich Wrecks Zagreb 9-2 in Champions League First Edition

Harry Kane scored four goals in the first match of the UEFA Champions League this season, leading Bayern Munich Germany to a great victory.

Bayern Munich beat Dynamo Zagreb Croatia 9-2 at home in the first leg of the Champions League phase at Allianz Arena in Munich, Germany on the morning of the 18th. Kane scored three goals with only penalties, driving in four goals. Michael Olise scored two goals, and Rafael Geheiro, Leroy Zane and Leon Goretzka each scored one.

It is the first time that Kane has scored three goals from penalty kicks alone in the European club competition. Kane, in particular, achieved a hat trick in two consecutive official games following an away game against Holstein and the German Bundesliga on the 15th.메이저놀이

Kane scored the opening goal at the 19th minute of the first half. Kane easily scored a goal from Aleksandar Pavlovic's penalty kick. Kane then pushed Jozua Kimmich's shot into the net at the 12th minute of the second half when the score was 3-2, and pushed it with his right foot. Kane took the opportunity again with a penalty kick at the 28th minute of the second half when his team was leading 5-2, and scored a hat-trick. Kane then scored another goal with a penalty kick at the 33rd minute of the second half when the score was 6-2.

Bayern Munich center back Kim Min-jae started the game and worked with Dayo Upamecano. Kim was replaced by Eric Dier in the 24th minute of the second half. However, he failed to block Zagreb's Marco Pacha in Bayern Munich's first loss at the 3rd minute of the second half, providing an excuse.
