

Pittsburgh pitching prospect Shim Jun-seok transferred to Miami in trade

The Pittsburgh club of the Major League Baseball (MLB) said on the 31st (Korea time) that "it gave up pitcher Shim Joon-seok and infielder Garrett Forester to Miami and made a trade to acquire outfielder Brian De La Cruz."

Shim Jun-seok, who threw a fastball in the late 150km/h range when he was a high school student, was called the biggest fish in high school. He signed a 750,000-dollar contract with Pittsburgh in January last year after declaring that he will go to the U.S. ahead of the 2023 KBO Rookie Draft.

Shim did not play in many games in the Minor League Rookie League last season, but showed promise. In four games, Shim had three hits (one homer) and three walks, 13 strikeouts and three runs in eight innings. 토토사이트 모음

Shim Jun-seok, who is ranked 17th in the Pittsburgh Pirates' promising players list, has no record of playing this year. Due to his shoulder injury, he failed to play in the actual game. Meanwhile, Cruz, who will join the Pittsburgh Pirates, is a resource that can immediately play in the big leagues. He played in 105 games in the MLB this year and posted a batting average of 0.245 104 hits, 18 homers and 51 RBIs.
