



Dermadrozan To Sacramento For 3 Years, \$74 Million

All-Star forward Derma DeRozan (34) heads west.

"ESPN" cited sources on the 7th (Korea Standard Time) and said DeRozan agreed to a three-year, \$74 million contract with the Sacramento Kings.

DeRozan will move his team to a sign-and-trade format.

Sacramento gives up Harrison Barnes to the San Antonio Spurs in exchange for DeRozan, sending Chris Duarte, two draft picks, and cash to Chicago.

It will also send pick swaps for the 2031 draft to San Antonio.

DeRozan is a six-time All-Star and three-time All-NBA veteran. He has played 1110 games in the NBA since being selected by the Toronto Raptors with the ninth overall pick in the 2009 draft.

This season, he averaged 37.8 minutes in 79 games, scoring 24 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 5.3 assists per game. He ranked second in voting for Clutch Player of the Year.

However, he has not been able to move forward since then. He won 46 games last season, but lost in the seed game, failing to advance to the playoffs.

With this acquisition, Sacramento has secured a key player to lead the team along with Domantas Sabonis and De'Aaron Fox.
