



'Attempted Racism' Enzo even committed a crime this time

Enzo Fernandez had another accident.

"Enzo Fernandez was convicted of a new crime a few days after posting a racist video against the French national team, facing the longest Premier League ban ever."

Argentina won the 2024 Copa America Colombia at Hard Rock Stadium in Florida with a 1-0 victory. The incident happened after the final match.

After Argentina's victory, Chelsea midfielder Enzo Fernandez posted a video on social media celebrating with his teammates on the team bus. In the video, Argentina's players can be heard shouting racist chants at the French players.

The slogan was translated as "They play in France, but their parents are from Angola. My mother is from Cameroon, and my father is from Nigeria. But the passport says French," and the racist remark was quickly spread through social media

Enzo's Chelsea teammate Wesley Fofana made his feelings clear on social media. Chelsea said they have opened an internal investigation into the incident. Enzo could be banned from the stadium following his claim that he could face sanctions of up to 12 games.

If Enzo is banned, it will likely be imposed by the FA, not his club. In August 2020, the FA stated that "six to 12 game-based sanctions will be recommended to the regulatory committee for almost all discriminatory acts by individual participants."

In other words, if the FA decides to investigate the case, Enzo will almost certainly face a minimum six-game ban. It has also not ruled out the possibility, though the FA has not yet begun proceedings against Enzo.

Meanwhile, Enzo was found guilty of not identifying himself as the driver of Porsche, which has now committed a driving violation, according to The Sun. [토토사이트](#)

Enzo was indicted in December last year on charges of failing to provide relevant information to the police department. Enzo was convicted last Wednesday for allegedly missing a hearing

in a district court. Enzo is scheduled to be sentenced on Sept. 11 on trial.

Enzo was charged with driving a Porsche Cayenne in Llanelli Church Street on November 28, 2023. He was also accused of driving the same vehicle uninsured on the same day. However, he did not appeal the charges and the charges were dropped.
