

Professional volleyball women's FA's biggest fish, Kang So-hwi and Lee So-young, came to the market

Kang So-hwi and Lee So-young, the biggest female professional volleyball free agent FA, free agent, came to the market.

The Korea Volleyball Federation KOVO announced 18 women's FA qualified players on the 4th.

13 people, including Kang So-hwi, Lee So-young, Jung Ji-yoon, Kim Mi-yeon, Lee Won-jung, Lee Ju-ah, Yellow, Park Eun-jin, Park Hae-min, Han Su-ji, Han Da-hye, Kim Ha-kyung, and Ko Ui-jeong, were listed in Group A, while 5 people, including Na Hyun-soo, Kim Joo-hyang, Choi Eun-ji, Kim Hyun-jung and Kim Hae-bin, were listed in Group B.

In particular, Kang So-hwi, Lee So-young and Jung Ji-yoon are the top players to be recruited for teams that need outside heater left striker resources.

Eleven players, including Jung Ji-yoon, Na Hyun-soo, Kim Joo-hyang, Lee Won-jung, Lee Juah, Park Eun-jin, Park Hye-min, Kim Ha-kyung, Kim Hyun-jung, Ko Ui-jeong and Kim Hae-bin, became FA qualifications for the first time in their lives.

Group A has players with an annual salary of more than 100 million won 865,052 U.S. dollars. A team that recruits a player from Group A must compensate the original team with one player designated by the original team among the players other than 200 percent of the previous season's annual salary and six protected players including the option to protect or protect the FA players for the current year, or pay a transfer fee of 300 percent of the previous season's annual salary. In this case, the compensation method is decided by the original team.

Group B is a player whose annual salary ranges from 50 million won to less than 100 million won. The club that recruits players in Group B must compensate 300 percent of the annual salary of the previous season. There is no compensation player.

Clubs and players can freely negotiate until 6 p.m. on the 17th.
