

Volleyball Empress 'Dream of Winning' Upended a Year ago

After the end of the last season, Kim Yeon-koung of Heungkuk Life in women's professional volleyball was in a dilemma. She agonized over extending her active career and retiring. She decided to stay on the court. She had a clear goal. "I had a bigger desire to win. I want to achieve my goal," Kim said. "It may be difficult, but I want to try again."

She deserves the win. Kim won the title for two consecutive years, namely the 2005-2006 season and the 2006-2007 season, when she debuted. In both seasons, she swept all the MVP awards in the regular league and the championship game. In the 2008-2009 season, she led the team to the championship title, and became the MVP. Since then, she has expanded her career to overseas leagues. She has performed in Japan, Turkiye, and China, making her name a volleyball empress.

He returned to the V-League for the 2020-2021 season. In the same year, he ranked second in the regular league and second in the match against Champ. After spending another year in Shanghai, China, he joined Heungkuk Life Insurance last season. Although he finished the regular league as No. 1 player, he suffered a reverse sweep due to three consecutive losses after two consecutive wins against Korea Expressway Corporation in the match against Champ, the best-of-five series. Although he increased his chance of winning the championship to 100 percent by winning two consecutive games, he failed to solve the last puzzle. He lost his chance of winning the championship by a bitter runner-up.

He is aiming for the top spot again this season. Despite ups and downs, Heungkuk Life Insurance has continued its race to become the leader. She scored 16 points 45.45% attack success rate to defeat Hyundai E&C. She won the set score 3-0 completely. She continued her challenge to rank No. 1 by blocking Hyundai E&C from winning on her own.

As of Thursday, Hyundai E&C ranks first with 77 points 25 wins and 10 losses, while Heungkuk Life Insurance ranks second with 76 points 27 wins and 8 losses. The gap between the two teams is just one point. Heungkuk Life Insurance will play its last regular-season game against GS Caltex on April 15 and Hyundai E&C will play against Pepper Savings Bank on April 16. Heungkuk Life Insurance will have to add three points first before watching Hyundai E&C's game. If the two teams have the same final points, Heungkuk Life Insurance, which is ahead in wins, can win a dramatic reversal. <u>토토사이트</u>
