

Korean pitching and batting strikeouts. Jang Hyunseok will chew 25K in 13 innings

Jang Hyun-seok, a promising player on the Los Angeles Dodgers rookie team, took the mound as an intermediate pitcher and struck out two in one inning, neatly blocking no hits and no runs.

Jang Hyun-seok pitched a scoreless pitch as the third pitcher in the top of the second inning in a home game against the San Diego Padres rookie team on the 23rd (Korea time).

Sterling Patrick Starling took the mound as the starting pitcher for the first time this season, but failed to finish the first inning. He allowed three hits, including two doubles, a walk, and a hit ball, and gave up four runs in $\frac{2}{3}$ innings

He was replaced by Alvaro Benoit. As soon as Benoit came up, he allowed a hit, dedicating one run to the team and allowing one more run on wild pitches, increasing Patrick's loss to six. With his team trailing by a wide margin of 0-6, Jang came up as the third pitcher in the top of the second inning. Jang, who grounded out the first No. 2 Spence Coffman to second base, faced off against No. 3 Choi Byung-yong.

Choi Byung-yong (22) graduated from Shinil High School and went to New Mexico Military School to study, and was named the 20th round and 611th by San Diego in 2023.

Jang struck out Choi, followed by a swing and miss strikeout by No. 4 Addison Coppack, who finished the top of the second inning easily. He replaced him with Cole Crescend in the top of the third inning.

The Dodgers chased Jose Hernandez with a two-run shot in the bottom of the second inning, but lost 3-8.

In the game against the Arizona Diamond Rookie on the 12th, Jang had three hits, two outs, three strikeouts and six runs (three earned) during the first ¹/₃ innings. However, in the game against the Texas Rangers on the 18th, he started the game and showed no hit, one walk and six strikeouts during three innings, wiping out the pain of his slump. He continued his pitching in the middle game.

Jang took the mound in eight games and started in five of them. He pitched 13 innings and allowed 10 hits and 12 runs, showing poor ERA at 8.31. However, he has displayed powerful performance by garnering as many as 25 strikeouts.
