

Poker Players Alliance Raises \$3M To Fight UIGEA

The Poker Players Alliance (PPA) continues to lead the charge of abolishing the unpopular UIGEA since 2006. Since its introduction, UIGEA has been largely unenforced and almost uniformly criticized for its ambiguous language. The only party that seems to be unopposed recently is the National Football League (NFL).

The PPA has raised funds to support former Senator Alphonse Damato to get a proposal through Congress as soon as possible. Rep. Barney Frank has fought since the UIGEA proposal, has already tried to pass several bills to block the law, and is currently preparing a new proposal due to be presented to Congress earlier this month. <u>아저하 파워볼사이트</u>

Another organization, the Interactive Media Entertainment and Gaming Association (iMEGA), has just been granted a hearing to appeal against UIGEA. They are scheduled to begin oral arguments on July 6, despite the Justice Department's efforts to get the Justice Department to determine that there is no reason.

The change of power with Obama's election has raised expectations that Democratic leaders will result in the reversal of a bill signed by Bush when it was introduced into the port bill.
