



## Hyundai Mobis Park Jun-eun's short and bold resolution, "I can't look back."

"I can't look back"

Hyundai Mobis has developed the No. 10 player several times, including Ham Ji-hoon (198cm, F), Chun Dae-hyun (current coach Hogye Middle School), and Song Chang-yong (191cm, F). In particular, Ham showed outstanding skills to become the unified MVP of the 2009-2010 season. People called Hyundai Mobis the team that created the 'No. 10 Shinhwa.'

Park Jun-eun (194cm, F) wore a uniform of Ulsan Hyundai Mobis as the 10th pick in the 2019 KBL domestic rookie draft. At the time, Hyundai Mobis coach Yoo Jae-hak (current head of KBL's game division) praised Park's possibility, saying, "We will pick a player who can write the 10th pick Shinhwa right after the draft."

During his time at Sungkyunkwan University, Park was regarded as a tall forward with height, speed, wide range of offense and defense, and scoring ability. Along with Lee Yoon-soo (204 cm, C), Sungkyunkwan University was placed in the championship game for the first time in the school's history in the 2019 college basketball league.

However, Park said, "I lacked many things. I learned everything new, including strength, defense posture, and shooting. I started from the basics under coach Park Gu-yeong. I played in 14 games in the 2019 KBL D-League, and gained a sense of play in actual games. He posted an average of 27 minutes and 21 seconds with 9.6 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 1.9 assists, which is not bad.

He only played in two matches in the first team. He played in a total of 3:46 a.m. He did not have enough time to gain experience in the first team. He had to be satisfied with his successful one out of one three-point shot.

However, Park yearned for the coat in the summer of 2023, too. His physical exercise, passion, and grit were as good as those of Hyundai Mobis. In particular, his performance came out during the off-season training in the Philippines, which was held in August 2023. Both Hyundai Mobis coach Cho Dong-hyun and Hyundai Mobis officials praised Park, saying, "(Park) Jun-eun was really good in the Philippines."

Park, however, barely made it to the first team in the 2023-2024 season. Of course, the number of appearances (7 games) and average playing time (6 minutes and 2 seconds) were career highs, but not the numbers to satisfy Park's passion.

Park Joon-eun said, "When I played in the regular league, I felt a lot of regret. I often missed easy shots and failed to fulfill the defense that the coach wanted. We have to fill that in the upcoming season," looking back on the 2023-2024 season.

Despite Park's efforts, Park didn't get a chance. This is because he didn't win the competition with his compatriots and didn't make good use of his opportunities. You have to think about these points this offseason.

Park said, "I am practicing one-on-one defense and team defense with my teammates. Personally, I need to perform defense perfectly. That way, I think I can play a little bit more in the game," starting with "defense."

"As I said before, we have to play a perfect one-on-one defense and a two-on-two defense. And we have to put it in an open chance no matter what," he said afterwards, emphasizing "shooting." [토토사이트 모음](#)

Finally, he said, "We have two years left on our contract. However, if we don't get a chance in the upcoming season, we won't get a chance in the next season either. We can't look back." The word "forward" seemed to cover Park's entire body.
