## Virat Kohli vs Sachin Tendulkar in T20I



Sachin Tendulkar played in India's inaugural T20I match against South Africa in 2006, but did not participate in the format at the international level thereafter. Virat Kohli, on the other hand, made his T20I debut in 2010 and has since become the highest run-scorer in the format, being the first player to reach 4,000 runs in T20Is.

Virat Kohli vs Sachin Tendulkar in ODI



Sachin Tendulkar is widely regarded as the best limited overs batsman ever and holds the record for being the only player to score more than 15,000 runs in this format. On the other hand, Virat Kohli has shown his prowess in ODIs over the past ten years and has cemented his reputation as a master of run chases. With an average of over 58, he has the highest average among batters with more than 6,000 runs in this format.

#### Virat Kohli vs Sachin Tendulkar Test



Sachin Tendulkar dominated [Test cricket](#) with 51 centuries and a total of 15,921 runs at an average of 53.79. On the other hand, Kohli has also excelled in the longest format with seven

double centuries, the most by an Indian batter, surpassing Tendulkar and Sehwag's record of six double tons.
