

What is the situation at Ariake Arena ahead of the Korea-Japan match?

The Korean men's basketball team is scheduled to have a showdown with the Japanese national team at Ariake Arena in Tokyo on May 5 and 7. This year's championship is based on the strong characteristics of a match against Japan, but Japanese fans were very enthusiastic about the match.

It was easy to see fans wearing red uniforms representing the Japanese national team near Odaiba in Tokyo, where the match will take place. The number got bigger as they headed toward the stadium, and when they arrived at the stadium, they were crowded.

Despite the hot weather of 33 degrees Celsius and 39 degrees Celsius, Japanese fans visited the stadium two hours before the start of the game, and fans who entered the stadium showed their focus not to miss any gestures of the players.

The souvenir shop in the stadium was also crowded. The line to buy the players' back numbers and uniforms with their names on them was endless, and the line to buy drinks with the players' faces printed on them was also quite long.

The enthusiasm for news coverage was also feverish. Media and photos on TV and reporters began to enter the venue from 17:00 p.m. With the number of reporters restricted to 200, reporters had to hurry to gain preferential seats. This part showed interest in Japanese basketball fans ahead of the game.
