Understand the Broadcast Limit Structure

1. Recipients Limit per List (256 contacts)

Each broadcast list can contain up to 256 recipients. If you need to reach more, multiple lists must be created.

2. Daily Sending Limit — Tiered System

WhatsApp Business App limits the number of unique daily recipients, not the number of messages. The tier progression typically flows like this:

- Level 1: Up to 1,000 unique users/day
- Level 2: Up to 10,000 unique users/day
- Level 3: Up to 100,000 unique users/day
- Level 4: Unlimited unique users/day

Your daily capacity grows with improved reputation and engagement.

3. No Limit with WhatsApp Business API

The API removes daily and per-broadcast caps, but performance relies on maintaining a good quality score and abiding by WhatsApp's policies.

Why WhatsApp Broadcast Limits Exist

These restrictions are in place for several reasons:

- Preventing Spam: Keeps messages relevant and prevents user harassment.
- Maintaining Quality: Encourages businesses to focus on targeted, meaningful messaging.
