How to Reach the Clinic:

- **From Western Line:** Take a local train to Malad station, then use a taxi or auto-rickshaw to reach Globus Hospital, which is about 1.5 km away.
- **From Central Line:** Travel to Dadar station(Central Line), transfer to the Western Line, and proceed to Malad Station, then follow the same route as above.
- **From Out of Mumbai by Flight:** Fly to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport. From there, you can take a taxi directly to the hospital, which is approximately 14 km away.
