About The Dubai Fountain



The Dubai Fountain graces the 12-hectare (30-acre) Burj Khalifa Lake, a centrepiece of Downtown Dubai in the UAE. Designed by California-based WET Design, known for the Bellagio Hotel fountains in Las Vegas, this spectacle features 6,600 lights and 25 coloured projectors.

Spanning 275 metres (902 feet), it jets water up to 152.4 metres (500 feet) high, synchronised with a diverse repertoire of classical, contemporary Arabic, and world music. Created for AED 800 million (USD 218 million), it's a testament to Dubai's penchant for grandeur and innovation in entertainment architecture.

How To Reach The Dubai Fountain?



By Metro

Burj Khalifa, or Dubai Mall Metro Station, is the nearest metro station to the Dubai Fountain. It's on the Red Line. From the station it's a short walk through an air-conditioned walkway that connects directly to the Dubai Mall. You can also get off at the Business Bay Metro Station. It is also on the Red Line, this station is a bit farther but can be a less crowded option.

By Bus

Several bus routes stop near the Dubai Fountain. You can take Route 27, which runs from Deira Gold Souk station to The Dubai Mall, route 29, from Ghubaiba bus station to The Dubai Mall, and Route F13, which runs from the Stops at the Dubai Mall and Burj Khalifa.

By Taxi

Taxis are readily available throughout Dubai and offer a convenient way to get to the Dubai Fountain. You can also use ride-hailing services like Uber and Careem.

By Car

If you're driving, you can park at the Dubai Mall. The mall offers a large parking lot with over 14000 parking spaces, and parking is free for the first two hours.

By Air

If you're flying into Dubai, you can take a taxi or a metro from the Dubai International Airport. The metro connects directly to the Dubai Mall via the Red Line.

By Traditional Abra

For a unique experience, take a traditional Abra boat ride across Burj Lake to reach the Fountain. This option not only provides transportation but also a scenic view of the fountain and the surrounding area.
