If you can't get your ring resized immediately, a temporary solution is to use a ring guard or sizing beads. However long-term use of these devices can damage the band over time.

How to Resize an Engagement Ring to Make It Bigger

Resizing a ring to make it larger is slightly more complex. For small adjustments, your [jewelry store in Boulder, CO](#) can stretch the metal band.

However, if the ring needs to be increased by more than half a size, they'll need to cut the band and add additional metal to achieve the desired fit.

This process requires precision and may be more costly, but it ensures a secure and lasting result.

Rings That Can and Cannot Be Resized

Rings made from metals like gold, platinum, and silver are ideal for resizing. Bands with minimal stone settings also make the process easier.

On the other hand, certain rings are difficult, or impossible, to resize. These include eternity bands as the stones encircling the band leave no room for adjustment, tungsten bands, and titanium bands as the metal's hardness makes them unworkable.

If resizing isn't an option, consider using a secondary, tighter ring to hold your engagement ring in place. Alternatively, consult a jeweler about remaking the ring in the correct size.

Does your engagement ring spin on your finger or feel uncomfortably snug? It might be time to visit a jeweler. A properly fitted ring should slide on easily but require a little effort to remove.
