Seoni is the nearest train station to Pench. But there are only two trains running between Jabalpur and Seoni, so check schedules carefully.

By Road:

Driving is the easiest and most enjoyable way to reach Pench from Jabalpur. The distance is around 200 km and takes approximately 4 to 5 hours. The roads are mostly good, and you can stop at local dhabas along the way for snacks and tea.



Weekend Itinerary
