It is estimated that more than 360 million websites were hosted on Tumblr as of November 2018. That's an awful lot of blogs!

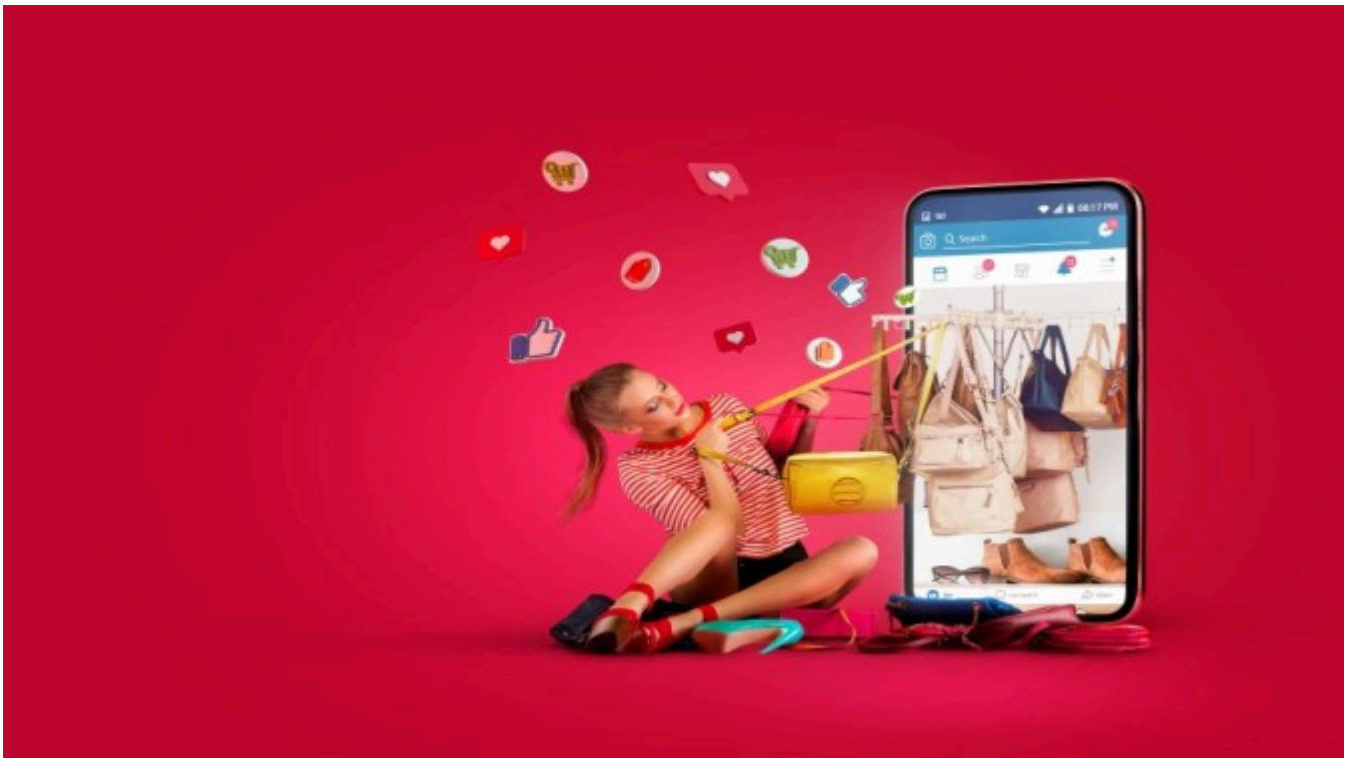

Great Ideas for Some Great Tumblr Blog URLs

Use [Thesaurus.com](https://www.thesaurus.com)



Thesaurus.com makes creating Tumblr URLs a breeze when you enter any word and find out what synonyms are available. Simply type in any word into the search bar and you'll see an alphabet of words that have similar meanings.

Consider your blog's topic and the content you intend to write about, a term that reflects your interests or the acronym you're using, or something else, and then start looking. You might be surprised at the number of great terms that pop up that other users of Tumblr haven't yet used.

Use a Random Word Generator

Need help with word ideas to start? You can use a clever tool such as WordGenerator.net to assist you.

Getting new ideas is as simple as clicking Generate Random Words. Keep clicking until you find something you're interested in. The definition for each word is provided under the word itself.

It is possible to make a list of words you're interested in from WordGenerator.net and add them to Thesaurus.com for a look at what other words you could create. There are endless possibilities here.

Incorporate Multiple Words Into Your URL

Even if you've selected an odd word there's the chance of getting a single-word Tumblr URL. If you are able to make it longer by using two or three phrases, you'll get more chances of success.

Many people utilize complete words on their Tumblr URLs and if you don't mind the length of your URL, this may be an ideal route to follow.

Use Slang, Acronyms, Numbers, or Even Misspelled Words

There's a great chance of obtaining the Tumblr URL you're looking for when you are creative in using popular slang terms such as acronyms, numbers, or even misspelled words. It's not a bad idea, but it's a bit silly however it could not be a good choice for an enterprise Tumblr blog, but if you're creating a simple blog, then it may be a good idea.

For instance, it is possible to replace any letter O with zero. You could also include "LOL" as an acronym "LOL" in it. It's a minor modification that could lead to an enormous impact.

Check Out These Tumblr Tags

There are occasions when people promote free Tumblr URLs or even post on their Tumblr about trading one they already have, so take an eye on tags such as good URLs and URLs to find what's available. If you've already created a Tumblr blog you can create your own post and add one of these tags to request assistance in renaming your blog, which is an that a lot of users use on Tumblr.

Remember your Tumblr URL isn't fixed in solid stone. It is possible to change it whenever you like through your settings, choosing your blog, and then altering the address.
