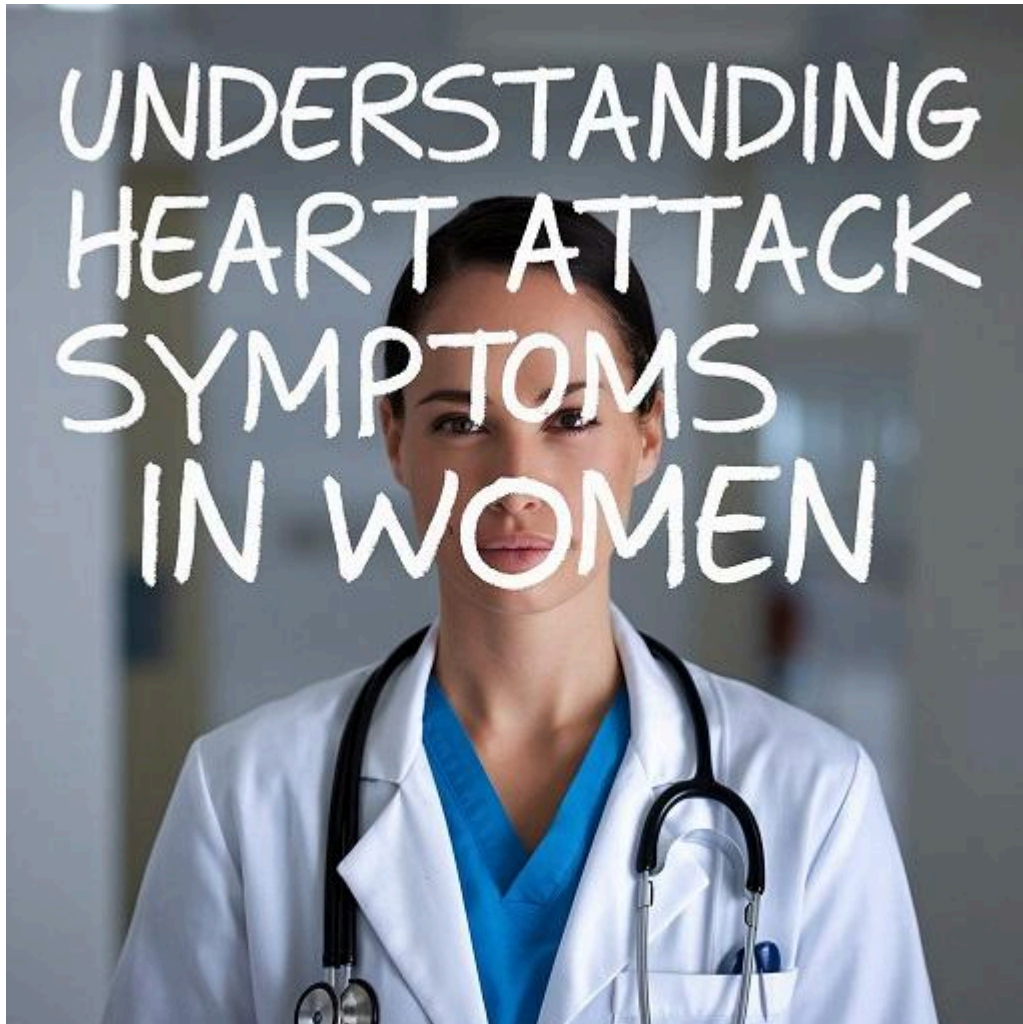




Understanding Heart Attack Symptoms in Women
