## What Is Ayahuasca?

from the Ayahuasca vine (*Banisteriopsis Caapi*) and Chacruna leaves (*Psychotria Viridis*), this sacred brew opens a portal to deep inner healing, connection with nature, and spiritual insight.

One ceremony with Ayahuasca is often described as the emotional equivalent of 10 years of therapy. But this isn't a magic cure. It's a journey. One that asks you to enter with courage, an open heart, and a willingness to face your shadows.

## Legal and Sacred in the USA

963 Tribe Church operates as a legally recognized religious organization under the 508(c)(1) (A) provision. This means that their sacred plant ceremonies are not only protected by the First Amendment but are also treated with the utmost reverence and safety.

These are not recreational experiences. They are spiritual sacraments, woven into the fabric of deeply held beliefs and guided by skilled facilitators with respect for ancient Shipibo traditions.

## What Makes 963 Tribe Church Different?

At **963 Tribe Church**, everything starts with intention. The community is inclusive and diverse, welcoming all walks of life. Each ceremony is designed to be a safe and sacred space — free from judgment, filled with love and spiritual support.

The facilitators honor Shipibo traditions from Pucallpa, Peru. These roots guide the ceremonies, the music (called icaros), and the entire experience. From the moment you arrive, you're held in a container of compassion, connection, and celebration.

## How It Works: The Ceremony Experience

A lot of care goes into preparing your body, mind, and spirit for this journey:

### **Before Ceremony:**

- Avoid processed foods, red meat, alcohol, caffeine, and stimulants.
- Discontinue medications like SSRIs and MAOIs at least 4 weeks prior.
- Abstain from sexual activity, media overload, and anything that clouds your mind.

### **Ceremony Day:**

- Eat lightly or fast for at least 6 hours before ceremony
- Show up with presence, intention, and respect.
- Let go of expectations and prepare to surrender to the experience.

### **After Ceremony:**

- Integration is everything. Journaling, time in nature, and community support are key to processing what you've learned.

## **The Power of Integration**

The ceremony doesn't end when the sun rises. In fact, the real work begins afterward.

You return home with a new perspective, but what happens when your daily life doesn't understand your transformation? This is where integration becomes vital.

963 Tribe encourages daily spiritual practices like meditation, music, nature walks, or journaling to help ground the wisdom you've received. They also offer community support, because staying connected to like-minded souls can make all the difference.

## **Real-Life Transformation**

Many people come to 963 Tribe Church burdened with emotional pain, anxiety, or spiritual emptiness. After experiencing sacred Ayahuasca ceremonies, they leave with renewed purpose, emotional clarity, and a deeper connection to the divine.

Ayahuasca can bring up fear, grief, and difficult emotions — but it does so with purpose. As 963 Tribe teaches, this sacred sacrament shines a bright light on your shadow, helping you face and release what no longer serves you.

## **Creating a Safe and Sacred Space**

Safety, consent, and inclusion are cornerstones of the 963 Tribe experience. Participants are asked to honor clear guidelines to protect the sacred space:

- No touching others without consent
- No electronics
- Silence during the ceremony
- Full disclosure of medications and health history

This isn't just about rules — it's about reverence. Every element is designed to create a container of trust and transformation.

The name "963 Tribe" is inspired by the 963 Hz Solfeggio frequency — often called the "God frequency." It is believed to activate the crown chakra and deepen our connection to Divine consciousness. At 963 Tribe Church, sound and music are sacred tools that align us with our higher selves and with the Creator.
