The agency has committed itself as a competitor in the Google Lunar X-Prize. +++ Bigelow Aerospace -- North Las Vegas, Nevada space technology startup company founded in 1999 by hotelier Robert Bigelow. Bigelow has reserved a 2011 launch on the SpaceX [founded by PayPal co-founder Elon Musk] Falcon 9 rocket [manufactured by SpaceX]. Blue Origin -- Privately-funded aerospace company set up by Amazon.com founder Jeff Bezos. Under the current timetable, Blue Origin will fly unmanned in 2011 and manned in 2012.
